This is the electronic final response to your June 10, 2017, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) for all charges to charge cards (both central and individual) for the listed individuals traveling to Palm Beach, FL (Mar a Lago) from March 3-5, 2017: Secretary John Kelly, Deputy Secretary Elaine Duke, Chief of Staff Kirstjen Nielsen, Executive Secretary Scott Krause and Military Advisor Read Admiral Joanna Nunan. This office received your amended request on June 20, 2017.

In responding to a FOIA request, DHS will search for responsive documents in its control on the date the search began. We began our search on June 20, 2017. A search of Chief Financial Officer (CFO) for documents responsive to your request produced a total of two pages. The information on page 2 reflects travel information for the Secretary.

We are granting your request under FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, and DHS FOIA regulations at 6 C.F.R. Part 5. After carefully reviewing the responsive documents consisting of travel expenses for the Secretary and his Chief of Staff, I determined that they are appropriate for public release. The documents are enclosed in their entirety; DHS has claimed no deletions or exemptions. Page two of the records are travel expenses for the Secretary for the time period in the request. These were the only two individuals from the names in the request that incurred travel expenses for this time period.
